Electronic Smoking Devices Added to Maine's Smoke-free Public and Workplace Laws

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN? It means that anywhere where traditional cigarettes are banned, electronic smoking devices are also not allowed thanks to LD 1108. Examples include: indoor or outdoor dining, bars, schools, child care centers, state parks, or movie theaters.

RISK OF 2ND HAND EXPOSURE?

E-cigarette aerosols may include:

- nicotine
- acrolein (weed killer)
- formaldehyde
- cancer causing chemical: acetaldehyde.
- cadmium, nickel, and lead
